

LX LEAGUE RULES REVISED AFTER 2017 AGM.

- 1) The bowler shall be 60 years of age before the fixture.
- 2) Matches are to consist of 4 triples to be played under BE rules, home one year away the next year. Additional triples may be arranged subject to agreement by both clubs but will not be included in the score.
- 3) Starting time for all league matches will be 2 pm. There will be a match fee of 50 pence which includes tea and biscuits after 9 ends. To be paid to the home club. (Only, and only by mutual agreement played continuously for all 18 ends.)
- 4) Fixtures should commence in May and finish in mid September before the league AGM.
- 5) The Ron Ault trophy is a 2 triple knock out competition, rounds to be played by mutual agreement the dates directed by the LX Secretary. The home team must offer their opponents three dates which must be week days. The final is to be played on a neutral ground
- 6) A total of 10 points will be awarded for each match. 2 points for each winning triple, 1 point for each point for overall win.
- 7) **If a club is short of one player, then one rink will play the team with three players 2 woods and 2 players 3 woods each. The score of the team with 2 players will be reduced by 331/3. They will be included in the overall score of their club. There will be no provision for a club 2 players short cancelling games a minimum of 9 players will be accepted, the team short of players will automatically receive 0 points.**
- 8) In the event of bad weather before or during a game the two captains have a number of options: a) 9 ends on all rinks, score to stand as a result of the match. b) Declare the match drawn, each club gets 5 points c). Fixture to be rearranged, League secretary to be advised.
- 9) In the event of two or more clubs sharing the lead on points the best shot difference will be the winner.
- 10) Dress greys and white above the waist or official club shirts (white tailored shorts may be worn if home clubs rules allow it.)
- 11) Skips may visit the head once each end. Standing in the head counts as a visit.
- 12) An affiliation fee of £5.00 per year to be paid to league secretary, League Secretary will receive money from fees for expenses as agreed by League at AGM
- 13) The Linton Rose Bowl will be presented to league winners to be held for 1 year. (Winner's of the Bowl will receive £40.00 towards the cost of hosting the AGM in the following year). The Hocknell Cup will be presented to the league runners up.
- 14) The draw for the Ron Ault Trophy will take place at the league AGM..
